

Acceptable Use Policy for Hodge Podge Hosting Services

All customers of services provided under the Hodge Podge Hosting brand (“Customer(s)”), including but not limited to virtual server hosting, data storage, colocation, and internet connections, are subject to this Acceptable Use Policy. Violation of this Acceptable Use Policy may result in immediate termination of Hodge Podge Hosting services. This document may change without notice to Customers as certain circumstances change, so you should check it from time to time for updates.

No Customer shall:

1. Violate the Acceptable Use Policy (or any similar policy restricting allowed activities) of any of Conduit Implementations’ upstream vendors. This includes, but is not limited to, the following Acceptable Use Policies:

2. Use services provided under the Hodge Podge Hosting brand for any activity that is illegal in any jurisdiction the Customer or Conduit Implementations is subject to the authority of. This includes, but is not limited to, the cities of Sunnyvale, Palo Alto, and Fremont, California, the state of California, and the country of the United States of America. Such activities may include:
 - Unauthorized access to computer systems (“hacking”)
 - Violation of intellectual property, such as copyright or trademark (“piracy”)
 - Fraud
 - Distribution and/or possession of child pornography
3. Compromise or threaten the integrity of the Hodge Podge Hosting network
4. Compromise or threaten the integrity of any Internet or non-Internet network
